This term we will be learning about our topic 'Why do squirrels hide their nuts?' We will be exploring these types of questions and more based on the children's lines of enquiry and curiosity. Our possible lines of enquiry may include seasonal change in the natural world, hibernation and migration, autumn foods and woodland animals.

Alongside this we will continue to work on our phonics, using kinetic letters to form our letters and sentences and we will be exploring the mathematical concepts of '1,2,3,4 and 5'.

Home learning

We would love you to read with your child as much as you can. The reading books we send home are just one way to support this. Other ways could be reading street signs, recipes when cooking or creating shopping lists or sharing favourite stories together.

We are working hard on our letter recognition, with a particular focus on writing our names. We would encourage you to continue to support your child with this at home.
