TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN

The aim of this plan is to minimise, as far as possible, the health and safety risk to all users (staff, children, parents and visitors) of the school site.

Parking

The car park is accessible to staff, parents and to visitors to both the school and the community centre. All of the above people are allowed to park in the car park. There are disabled bays available for the use of disabled drivers. The car park will be locked when the community centre or school closes (whichever comes first) any vehicle left in the car park will be locked in.

Staff

Priors Hall staff do not have any control over the car park. Drivers are responsible for the safety of pedestrians whilst using the car park.

Pupils

Children should be made aware of traffic and road safety issues.
Cycling/scooting is not permitted on the school site except during cycling tuition sessions.
Children cycling to school should dismount at the school gate and bicycles/scooters should be walked to the covered cycle shelter in the playground.

Contractors

Contractors, including Grounds Maintenance staff, must report to the school office before accessing the school site to ensure safety measures are in place for the duration of their visit to the site.

Parents/Carers

Parents/carers can use the car park or use the drop off layby to drop off. Parents should not park their cars in the lay-by. This is for drop off only.

They should not park in the roads immediately surrounding the school. Cars should be parked safely and legally in Priors Hall Park and children walked the remaining distance to school.

Pedestrians

Pedestrian footways are clearly marked and should be used at all times.
