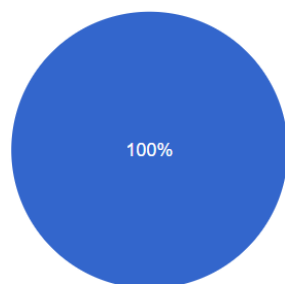


# RSE Parent Consultation

- No, I think the RSE policy could be clearer.

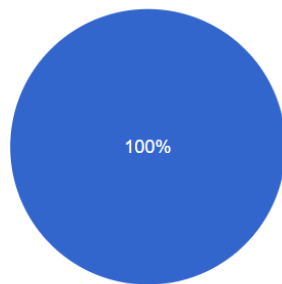

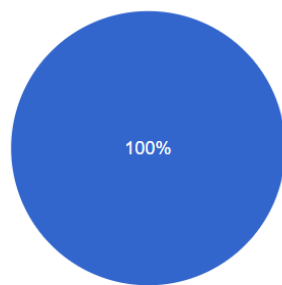

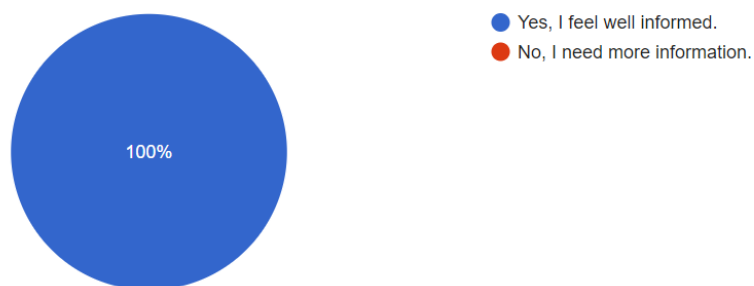

Q4: Do you understand how Priors Hall aim to be inclusive within their teaching of RSE?

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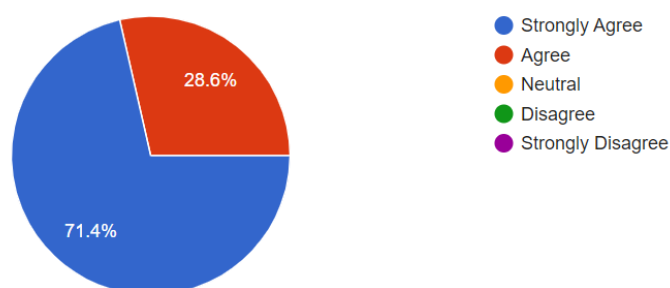
