
Year Four Newsletter — Summer 2

Reading

Please ensure that your child's planner and reading book are in school every day.

Children should be reading at least 5 times a week.

Water

It is crucial that every child arrives at school with fresh water in a named/labelled bottle, especially as the weather is getting warmer.

English

This term, we will be writing narratives based on imaginary worlds. We will be writing newspapers and focusing on improving our spelling skills. The children will be reading 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' by On jali Q. Rauf. They will explore how inference has been used to convey information about characters and how they can use this in their own writing.

Maths

Children will learn about turns and angles in shapes, comparing, identifying and ordering angles, recognising and describing 2-D shapes, triangles and quadrilaterals and lines of symmetry.

They will also be introduced to position, direction and translation on a coordinate grid for the first time.

Science

Our scientific focus this term will be:

Living Things and their Habitats

The children will explore the Topic 'Blue Abyss' and will be looking at our world's oceans, animal habitats and animal classi fication.

Year 4's focus in PE is:


Cricket

Children will need to come to school in their PE kit each Wednesday for this PE session.

Art and DT

Y4AB will be focusing on Art and Design skills looking at the fabric of nature. They will immerse in the sights and sounds of the rain forest, and be inspired to create a series of drawings, forming their ideas into a mood board. They will look at the artist William Morris and the Batik technique to create patterns on fabric.

Y4LB will use their Design and Technology skills to explore circuits and use this knowledge to design, create and evaluate torches. They will explore and choose who their target audience is and discuss why this is important.

Computing
