Year 1 Spring 1 – Seasonal Changes

"Science is the study of the physical and natural world through observation, testing, experimenting and evidence gathering"

Sun	A star that provides light and heat to the Earth.
Day	The time where it is light outside.
Night	The time where it is dark outside.
Season	The parts of the year are split into Autumn; Winter; Spring; Summer
Weather	The way the air and atmosphere feels
Temperature	The measured amount of heat in a place.



Deciduous trees lose their leaves in Autumn and Winter.



Evergreen trees keep their leaves or needles all year round.

Need to know knowledge

- There are 4 seasons in a year
- The seasons are Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer
- The weather changes throughout the year.
- The days are longer in the summer and shorter in the winter.
- It gets hotter in the summer and colder in the winter.
- Evergreen trees keep their leaves all year round whilst deciduous trees lose their leaves in Autumn and Winter.
